Comments:

We preferred to finish the third phase before beginning with the fourth phase. This is the reason the fourth phase was not completed because the funds received was not enough to complete all two phases. We are in need of US \$1,270 to complete final two phases. The following will be bought:

- 12m³ of sand x US\$ 25 =US\$ 300.00
 - 40 bags of cement x US\$ 19 =US\$ 760.00
 - Labors =US\$ 200.00
 - To complete transport =US\$ 10.00
- Total for finishing third and fourth phase = US\$ 1,270.00**

The Fifth phase: Interior ceiling

- 72 Triplex = US\$ 720.00
 - 320 rafters (chevrons) = US\$ 1,600.00
 - 100 Kg of nail = US\$ 350.00
 - 300 laths = US\$ 450.00
 - 300 liters of colors = US\$ 750.00
 - Transport of material = US\$ 150.00
 - Labors = US\$ 300.00
- Total of interior ceiling for fifth phase = US\$ 4,520.00**

The last need is to equip the clinic with materials

- 20 Ordinary metal beds = US\$ 2,000.00
 - 1 Birth bed = US\$ 800.00

 - 8 Ordinary tables = US\$ 560.00
 - 20 Wood chairs = US\$ 500.00
 - 1 Medicine chest "cupboard" (Closet) for pharmacy = US\$ 300.00
 - 1 Cupboard for maternity = US\$ 100.00
 - 1 Small cupboard = US\$ 80.00
 - Unexpected = US\$ 100.00
- Total to complete equipment of clinic = US\$ 5,540.00**

Your prayerful support is always welcome and very necessary. There are times when enthusiasm needs bolstering; times when the reality of how great the needs are and how desolate the conditions in which these precious souls must exist becomes overwhelming. The prayers you send are tangibly felt, and I humbly ask that lifting all who are involved up in prayer continue.

Yet as you can see from the report on the left, financial support is also critical if God's work is to continue. Once the initial goal of \$11,330 has been met, the facility will petition the government to change its statute definition to a hospital center, which means that a doctor will be able to make rounds on an as-needed basis, and that will facilitate performing minor surgeries to those who desperately need procedures. Medicines will also be supplied - first by the government and then by others, like our foundation, providing other necessities.

This is the "other face" of foundation work. The entreaties, the prayerful requests, in short, the asking. While I am not totally comfortable navigating in this area, I must humbly ask for your financial support. I ask on behalf of the wonderful people with whom The Wilkins Foundation is in contact almost daily. They need so very much, yet their gratitude for even the most basic supplies is shown with emotional praise to God for His love and mercy. Their reverence, their passion for God and their courage has put into perspective any struggles I may have faced in my own life. They are heroes yet they are not aware of their heroism. They are devout, yet their faith in God is as simple and as essential as breathing in and breathing out. They are truly beautiful souls, and it's our privilege to be associated with them.

And so I ask and will keep on asking, emboldened by your prayers and strengthened by God's promises. I have benefitted from God's healing mercies and rejoice in that I am now walking and gaining strength every day after being critically ill. God's not finished with me yet, and each sunrise I'm given serves to illustrate that there is still much to do.
